- 3. Unless otherwise ordered, on the business day next following the day on which a document is filed electronically, counsel must provide Chambers with one paper copy of the following e-filed documents:

<u>Criminal Cases</u>: All pleadings (including briefs and exhibits) supporting or opposing the following:

- a. Motions to dismiss the indictment;
- b. Motions to suppress:
- c. Motions to modify presentence reports;
- d. Requested jury instructions;
- e. Trial briefs; and
- f. Any other filing requested by the court.
