

FIVE DAYS PRIOR TO THE STATUS CONFERENCE, THE PARTIES SHALL INDIVIDUALLY OR JOINTLY SUBMIT THEIR STATUS REPORT(S) ELECTRONICALLY WITH CERTIFICATION TO ALL COUNSEL OF RECORD, STATING THE FOLLOWING:

- (1) THE STATUS OF THE CASE, IDENTIFYING ANY PENDING MOTIONS, OR ANY CIRCUMSTANCES POTENTIALLY INTERFERING WITH THE PARTIES' COMPLIANCE WITH THE SCHEDULING ORDER;
- (2) INTEREST IN REFERRAL FOR SETTLEMENT PURPOSES TO A UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE OR TO THE DISTRICT'S SPECIAL MASTERS PROGRAM;
- (3) WHETHER THE PARTIES WILL CONSENT TO A TRIAL BEFORE A MAGISTRATE JUDGE; AND
- (4) THE ESTIMATED LENGTH OF TRIAL.

NO STATUS REPORTS WILL BE ACCEPTED VIA FACSIMILE.

**THE PARTIES SHOULD BE PREPARED TO DISCUSS ANY PENDING MOTIONS, OR CONTEMPLATED MOTION, INCLUDING SUMMARY JUDGMENT, DAUBERT,ETC.**
