## Request for Circuit Council Approval

This is a request for authorization, for a period not to exceed 36 months, to solicit contracts for contract court reporters for the purpose of providing contract court reporting services for the District Court for the District of Connecticut.

It has been determined that the number of official court reporters provided to the District of Connecticut is insufficient to meet demands and needs and that the services of additional court reporters should be provided for the judges of the court. In particular, the services of court reporters should be provided on a contractual basis, rather than by appointment of additional official court reporters, to senior and magistrate judges as these judges are performing substantial judicial services for the District of Connecticut. In addition, the official court reporters are located in three different courthouses, thereby making it nearly impossible for them to pool services.

If this request is approved, the court will employ the services of a contract court reporter only if no official reporter is available, in accordance with the Court Reporter Management Plan for the District Court for the District of Connecticut.
