District of Connecticut Food and Beverage Policy

Any member of the public entering a District of Connecticut courthouse may bring personal food and beverage items into the courthouse, provided all such food and beverage items are x-ray screened by Court Security Officers. Food and beverage items not security screened are not permitted in a courthouse. The screening requirement does not apply to courthouse employees.

Food and beverages for group events (e.g., bar association meetings, court receptions) may be brought into a courthouse by a member of the public with the express permission of any judge resident in that courthouse.

Food and beverages shall not be brought into a courtroom without the express permission of the judge then presiding in that courtroom. Food and beverages shall not be brought into any federal office within a courthouse (e.g., Internal Revenue Service, U.S. Probation Office) unless that office affirmatively permits it.
