Pursuant to Judicial Conference Policy the members of this Merit Selection Panel who are eligible to apply for a magistrate judge position are restricted from applying for such a position for one year from the date of this Order. The undersigned sent written notification of this restriction to the members on May 15, 2025.

It is further ORDERED that the Panel report to the Court whether the incumbent is recommended for reappointment within ninety (90) days of appointment. This deadline may be extended at the request of the Panel. The Panel must review the incumbent's current service as magistrate judge and other experience, the comments from members of the bar and public, and other evidence of the incumbent's good character, ability, and commitment to equal justice under the law. A written report must be submitted by no later than August 18, 2025, unless an extension is needed.
