
Pursuant to the authority vested in me and with the consent of the Active Judges of the United States District Court for the District of Connecticut, the following action is taken:

The Order dated August 24, 1984, to the extent that it hires Robert L. Krechevsky and Alan H. W. Shiff as consultants in Bankruptcy matters is hereby revoked and they are hereafter referred to as Bankruptcy Judges;

The Order of Referral dated July 20, 1984, referring all matters arising out of Title 11 of the United States Code to the Bankruptcy consultants for the United States District Court for the District of Connecticut is hereby revoked;

It is now ORDERED pursuant to Section 157(a), Title 28, U.S.C., added by Section 104(a) of the Act of July 10, 1984, P.L. 98-353, and subject to the remaining provisions of Section 157, that all cases under Title 11, U.S.C., and all proceedings arising under Title 11, U.S.C., or arising in or related to a case under Title 11, U.S.C., pending on June 27, 1984, or filed on or after June 28, 1984, are referred to the Bankruptcy Judges for this District, to be assigned in accordance with their assignment rules.
